BayArt has been open to the public since 2003, but even before our public opening we were involved with the Wales wide Arts Education programme Opt for Art in 1998 and 1999. Since this time we have offered workshops to Primary, Junior and Secondary Schools in the South Wales Area.

- Facilities for visitors with Special Needs

The venue tries to accommodate the requirements of visitors with special needs. Schools and party leaders must ensure that suitable arrangements are in place in order that appropriate supervision and assistance is available to pupils with special needs.

Physical Impairment

Wheelchair access is possible throughout the site

Visual Impairment

The lighting level within indoor areas is very good

- First Aid

We have a first aid point within the gallery, in the gallery office; we do not have a qualified first aider on site

- Insurance(Public Liability)

We have public liability insurance.

- Maximum Party sizes

The venue caters for parties up to a maximum of 25 for Workshops. 40 for Gallery talks

- Medical Needs

The venue should be contacted by the school if any pupil is known to have any specific or serious medical condition /need. Discussion will be needed to consider emergency arrangements.

We will, where it is safe to do so, aim to fully include pupils with specific or serious medical conditions within activities offered.

- Required visitor conduct

Party leaders must not leave children unsupervised.

- Schematic map

Is available which includes authorised pedestrian routes, vehicle routes, coach parking areas as well as other items of interest.

- Welfare Facilities

Three public toilets are present (with disabled facilities) within the venue. All public conveniences are regularly cleaned.

An enclosed paved outdoor space, can be used as an eating area, during fine weather.

- Workshop information

Children might be asked to use materials such as charcoal or paint. To avoid damage to clothing, please bring aprons / protective clothing e.g a large shirt with sleeves trimmed.
